- Remember to make sure that you check things like gender and agreement.
 Remember that when you say '20 euro' in English it should be 'vingt euros' in French.
 - Ce gâteau not 'cette gâteau'.
- Sentences need a verb. 'Je ne le pas bien' ... I think you want to say 'Je ne l'aime pas bien.
- Be a little more careful with your pronouns etc.
 'Elle je n'aime pas' is incorrect: 'Elle n'aime pas'.
- Conjugate your verbs correctly: 'vous achetez' (don't forget the 'z').
- Remember that in a sentence with two or more verbs in a row only the first verb is conjugated. For example: 'nous devons achete' should be 'nous devons acheter'.
- In French we often need an article where wouldn't normally use one in English. For example: 'Josie aime bijoux' should be 'Josie aime les bijoux'.
